

1. Situation energy cooperatives in Belgium

- one very large: Ecopower °1991
 - producer/supplier
 - 60.000 members
 - 1,7 % market share households Flanders
 - supports other REScoops, presidency REScoop.eu
- about 30 smaller/younger REScoops
- REScoop Vlaanderen and REScoop Wallonie









2. Confronted/hindered by Wind Rush

most suitable places for wind turbines are speculatively taken by big developers, only 4% in hands of citizens





3. Non-binding community energy target

- 2 provinces Flemish Region: 20% participation
- Walloon Region: 24,99% + 24,99 % cadre de référence
- < 30 municipalities Flanders : 50% share for citizens
- push for binding %: keep the profits locally
- FINcoops: response of corporate developers
 - small percentage
 - subordinated loans





4. Clean Energy for All Europeans

- REScoop.eu advocated for definition for the existing members: production, distribution, supply, services, ...
- right for citizens and groups of citizens to participate actively in energy market
- CEC and REC
- member states have to set up support scheme
