

| | CLEAN ENERGY FOR EU ISLANDS | Covenant of Mayors for Climate & Energy |
|-----------------------------|--|---|
| Targets | Full decarbonisation | 20% emission reduction or 40% and adaptation actions |
| Timeframes | Before 2050 (long term) | 20% by 2020 (short term) 40% by 2030 (medium term) |
| Responsibilities and Scopes | Multi-stakeholder ISLAND responsibility (the pledge) | Municipality(ies) Municipal boundaries |
| Support | Supporting Organisations (all stakeholder groups including private business) | CoM Coordinators (Public entities) Supporters (not for profit orgs) |
| Key sectors | Transport (on - and to/from islands), energy production, heating/cooling | Private/public/tertiary buildings, Transport |






