that the Danish Island of Ærø is the winner of the 2020 edition of the EU RESponsible Island Prize. Ærø won the title in recognition for its innovative energy solutions and contribution to a sustainable Europe.

The "BaoBaB" technology is based on the use of highly engineered membranes, which are able to convert a salt solution into acidbase solutions.


