The event highlighted the importance of affordable and clean energy, with islands positioned as frontrunners in the journey towards full decarbonisation. Additionally, we hosted two workshops in Brussels, focusing on spatial planning and smart electricity systems to accelerate the decarbonisation of European islands. The workshops brought together island representatives, energy experts, and market actors to share best practices and innovative solutions for sustainable energy transitions.
